## Principles of The Cirkels

### **Principle 1:**

#### **The largest freedom of people is freedom to ask questions.**

Explanation: When someone is addressed this can lead to enthusiasm. This is however a short lived moment. Structural changes are reached by asking questions, resulting in people starting a thinking process. The realisation, insights and growth because of this thinking process will be permanent.

### **Principle 2:**

#### **The circles do not judge.**

Explanation; everyone who participates can discuss and appoint the facts, however without a judgement regarding these facts. A lot of energy is put in judgements and efforts to persuade others that these judgements are correct. This energy can be better used to listen with full attention to understand other perspectives on the facts.

### **Principle 3:**

#### **The circles are independent.**

Explanation; We cooperate with groups of people who are formally or informally organised on the condition that they respect our principles.

### **Principle 4:**

#### **Time spending is free.**

Explanation: Everyone is free to decide to how much time they devote to the circles.

### **Principle 5:**

#### **Promoting worldwide cooperation.**

Explanation: People feel themselves frequently united based their appearance, language, culture or geographical location. Cooperation between these different groups is encouraged and is facilitated.

### **Principle 6:**

#### **Look outside your circles.**

Explanation: Beside communicating with other languages, cultures and locations, also the cooperation with others outside the circles is encouraged and facilitated, if the principles of the circles are respected.

### **Principle 7:**

#### **No profit objective.**

Explanation: services are used which are made available unconditionally. Money is considered a service and is used as such. The services are used to achieve the objectives of the circles.
